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1. INTRODUCTION

Greetings from Manipal Academy of Higher Education (MAHE), Manipal to all the candidates who have appeared for Manipal Entrance Test (MET) 2026.

We welcome all successful candidates for the Online BPharm/PharmD Counseling 2026.

1.1 Disclaimer

Candidates with Manipal Entrance Test (MET) 2026 Rank are eligible for participation in the online BPharm / PharmD Counseling 2026

- All the candidates are requested to read the instructions carefully, before participating in the online Counseling process.
- Candidates are deemed to have read the Counseling Information Brochure and understood the counselling process, in addition to agreeing to the terms and conditions of the Online BPharm / PharmD Counselling process, before starting the registration process for participation in online BPharm / PharmD Counseling.
- All candidate may kindly note that mere registration for online BPharm/PharmD Counseling 2026 does **NOT** confer any automatic rights to secure a BPharm / PharmD seat.
 - The admission to the BPharm / PharmD program is subject to fulfilling the merit, admission criteria, eligibility, and such criteria as may be prescribed by UGC / PCI / MAHE Manipal
- Candidate should ensure that all the information filled in during the online submission of registration form is correct and factual. Information provided by the candidates in the online registration form shall be treated as correct & self-certified and MAHE Manipal shall not entertain, under any circumstances, any request for change in the information provided by the candidates
- Candidates must visit <https://manipal.edu/mcops.html> to know more about BPharm / PharmD programs, Fee Structure, Internships & Placements, Campus Life and also have first-hand information of the various infrastructure facilities like Department laboratories, Library, Hostel, Sports, etc. before filling the choices.
- All email and SMS communication to the candidates will be to the registered email id & mobile number provided at the time of completing the application form.
 - Queries (if any) must be emailed to official email id admissions@manipal.edu and response will be within 2 – 3 working days. MAHE Manipal cannot be held responsible for no-response to queries sent to any other email id.

1.2 . Participating Institution

BPharm / PharmD counseling 2026 will be conducted for admission to the BPharm / PharmD counseling programs offered by the following Institution.

- **Manipal College of Pharmaceutical Sciences (MCOPS), Manipal** <https://manipal.edu/mcops.html> (A Constituent Institute of Manipal Academy of Higher Education (MAHE), Manipal)

1.3 Eligibility Criteria

The candidates who fulfill the following eligibility criteria can participate in the 2026 counseling process

- Candidate should have MET 2026 rank
- Candidate should have passed in 10+2 / 'A' Level / International Baccalaureate (IB) / American High School Diploma or equivalent examination from a recognized board with Physics, Chemistry and English as compulsory subjects, with Biology / Mathematics as optional subjects from a recognized Board.
 - In each of these subjects, candidates should have scored at least minimum pass marks prescribed by the board
- Candidate should complete the age of 17 years on or before 31st December, of the year of admission to the course

Important Note

- *If a candidate fails in one / more subjects in 10+2 / 'A' Level / IB / American High School Diploma OR fails to secure minimum aggregate marks as mentioned above, he / she is **NOT** eligible to participate in the counseling. Allotted Seats to students awaiting their results, will be cancelled immediately if they do not fulfill the above eligibility criteria.*
- *For Candidates who possess a Senior Secondary Certificate from any Foreign Board / University and seek admission, are required to apply and obtain a certificate from the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) www.aiu.ac.in certifying that the examination passed is equivalent to the Indian Senior Secondary Examination.*

1.4 Counseling Rounds

Counseling involves 4 rounds as follows. Depending on University guidelines, an additional round(s) of counseling may be conducted.

- **Round 1 to 4 (Online rounds):** Online Registration is permitted at the beginning of 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th rounds. After registration, candidates are required to do the choice filling. Seats will be allotted as per MET 2026 rank, availability of vacancy and choice.

Note

The schedule of additional Rounds of online counseling (if any) will be announced later

1.4.1 Counseling Portal

All applicants are requested to access <https://apply.manipal.edu> for all the activities with respect to Online BPharm/PharmD Counseling

- Choice Filling will be through the applicant portal only
- Fee Payment on seat allotment will be through the applicant portal only
- On successful confirmation of Program fee payment, Provisional Admission Order can be downloaded from applicant portal only
- Opting Out & Withdrawal from Counseling process will be through counseling portal only

On completion of the admission process, all admitted students **MUST** report to the campus for the Orientation program / Class Commencement (whichever is earlier) and occupy the allotted hostels. Non-reporting to the Campus on the date of Orientation program / Class Commencement (whichever is earlier) will result in automatic Cancellation of Admission. On Cancellation of the admission the candidate must proceed with the Withdrawal option.

Withdrawal approval and refund process will be initiated only after the receipt of hard copy of the application submitted by the Candidate / Parent / Authorized Representative (in person) at the Admissions Office of the respective Campuses. Fees shall be refunded to an eligible student within *Forty-Five* days from the date of receipt of hard copy of the application. Refer www.manipal.edu/fees for more details.

2 COUNSELING PROCEDURE

There are 4 rounds of counseling. All rounds will be Online. *Depending on vacancy (if any), an additional round of counseling may be conducted after the 4rd Round.* The various steps in the counseling procedure are

1. Registration
2. Choice Filling
3. Seat Allotment

4. Program Fee Payment (Installment 1) & Balance Program Fee Payment (Installment 2)
5. Provisional Admission Order
6. Waitlisting
7. Hostel Booking

2.1 Registration

- Candidates will have to confirm their participation in the Online Counseling process by logging into <https://apply.manipal.edu> with Registered email id as login ID and password
- After login, click on “**Counseling**” tab on side navigation
- Click on “**Browse BPharm / PharmD**” link to know about the programs available.
 - Click on “**Download Information Brochure**” to download the **BPharm / PharmD Online Counseling Information Brochure**
- Click on “**Pay & Register Now**”
- Read the instructions. Select the check box. Click on “**Pay Now**” button
- Waitlist Deposit (Rs. 10,000) is to be paid online during the Registration process for the Counseling
 - Having made the payment, candidates will be eligible to provide their choices in order to participate in the Online Counseling process
 - On Seat allotment in any round, 1st installment fee must be paid by the candidate within the timeline specified, to confirm the seat allotment.
 - On program fee payment, the waitlist deposit (Rs. 10,000) paid at the time of registration will be converted into Refundable Caution Deposit, which is part of the Program fee.
 - Fresh Registration is allowed only at the beginning of 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th rounds
- Mere registration for the counseling does **NOT** guarantee the allotment of Seat.
 - Seat allotment depends on the candidates’ MET rank, number of candidates registering for the counseling, their choice of course / institution and the number of seats available.
- In case the candidate is **NOT** allotted any seat in any rounds of counseling, the waitlist deposit will be refunded within 2 months of completion of all rounds of Counseling

Important Note

- **BPharm:** On seat allotment, if the first year Program Fee (**1st Installment i.e. Rs. 2,40,000**) is NOT paid before the deadline, candidate is out of the counseling process and will also forfeit the waitlist deposit of Rs. **10,000**.
- **PharmD:** On seat allotment, if the first year Program Fee (**1st Installment i.e. Rs. 2,40,000**) is NOT paid before the deadline, candidate is out of the counseling process and will also forfeit the waitlist deposit of Rs. **10,000**
 - Balance Program Fee (**2nd Installment**) is to be paid as per the time line notified for each round.
 - If the balance first year Program Fee (**2nd Installment i.e. Rs. 1,67,000**) for BPharm Course & (**2nd Installment i.e. Rs. 3,50,000**) for PharmD Course is NOT paid before the deadline specified for that round, candidate is out of the counseling process and the 1st instalment fee paid will be refunded as per UGC Refund policy (Refer www.manipal.edu/fees for refund rules).

2.2 Choice Filling

Choice filling is permitted at the beginning of 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th round for the registered candidates only

2.2.1 First Time choice Filling

- After making payment of the waitlist deposit (Rs. 10,000), the candidate can fill in as many choices as possible
 - Click on **“Setup Preferences”**
 - Read the instructions. Click on **“Proceed to Setup”**
 - Move the Institute + Program preferences from **“Available Programs”** to **“Selected Programs”**
 - After selecting the programs, click on **“Save Choices”**. Without clicking on **“Save Choices”**, the options will not be saved.
 - To edit the Choices, click on **“Edit Choices”** and after editing click on **“Update Choices”**
- Choice 1 is mandatory
- Choice 2 is optional
 - *For Example, if your most preferred Program is BPharm at MCOPS Manipal, please click on “Add” button to move it from “Available Programs” to “Selected Programs” as Choice 1. If your second choice is PharmD at MCOPS Manipal, please click on “Add” button to move it from “Available Programs” to “Selected Programs” as Choice 2.*
 - On submission of options by the candidate, it is considered that candidates are very much interested in the options submitted, hence on seat allotment / upgradation, it will be accepted by the candidate. Once allotted, there is no process of reversal. Hence, you may give choice 2 ONLY if you are interested.
 - **Candidates are advised to fill in the choices (institutes and Programs) of their interest only**
 - After saving, download / save / print a copy of the filled choices for future reference.
 - **On seat allotment, if the first year Program Fee is NOT paid before the fee payment timeline, candidate is out of the counseling process and will also forfeit the waitlist deposit of Rs. 10,000 and will NOT be eligible for waitlisting for further rounds.**

Important Note

- Request you to fill the choices with the browser zoom option set to 100%
- Candidates are requested to check the correctness of filled choices by clicking “Print” button and save the file for their reference
- The portal will be blocked on Processing of Seat Allotment dates, hence Choice Filling will not be possible during these dates

2.3 Seat Allotment

- The Seat allotment in any round will be as per MET 2026 Rank, preferences provided and availability of the same.
- On seat allotment, if the first year Course Fee (**1st Installment i.e. Rs. 2,40,000) for BPharm Course & (1st Installment i.e. Rs. 2,40,000) for PharmD**) is **NOT** paid before the deadline specified for that round, candidate is out of the counseling process and will also **forfeit the waitlist deposit of Rs. 10,000**. Such candidates will now be considered as Exited Candidates with Forfeiture of Waitlist Deposit
 - On forfeiture, if the candidate wishes to participate in next round, he / she will have to register afresh by paying the waitlist deposit of Rs. 10,000.
 - The forfeited waitlist deposit of the previous rounds cannot be adjusted with the waitlist deposit fee of the subsequent rounds
- Balance Course Fee (**2nd Installment i.e. Rs. 1,67,000) for BPharm Course & (2nd Installment i.e. Rs. 3,50,000) for PharmD**) is to be paid as per the time line provided in Table 1, for the respective round of seat allotted.
 - Failure to make balance fee payment within the timeline provided, will lead to cancellation of allotted seat, candidate will be out of counseling process and paid fee will be refunded as per Refund Rules

(Refer Section 6)

2.4 Course Fee Payment

- **BPharm:** On seat allotment, if the first year Program Fee (**1st Installment i.e. Rs. 2,40,000**) is NOT paid before the deadline, candidate is out of the counseling process and will also forfeit the waitlist deposit of Rs. 10,000.
- **PharmD:** On seat allotment, if the first year Program Fee (**1st Installment i.e. Rs. 2,40,000**) is NOT paid before the deadline, candidate is out of the counseling process and will also forfeit the waitlist deposit of Rs. 10,000
 - Balance Program Fee (2nd Installment) is to be paid as per the timeline notified for each round.
 - If the balance first year Program Fee (**2nd Installment i.e. Rs. 1,67,000**) for BPharm Course & (**2nd Installment i.e. Rs. 3,50,000**) for PharmD Course is NOT paid before the deadline specified for that round, candidate is out of the counseling process and the 1st instalment fee paid will be refunded as per UGC Refund policy (Refer www.manipal.edu/fees for refund rules)

2.4.1 BPharm

On seat allotment, first year fees is to be paid within the stipulated timeline. To ease the burden of payment, MAHE Manipal has decided to allow part payment of the fees. The 1st year fee payment of Rs. **4,07,000** (excluding waitlist deposit of Rs. 10,000) is split into 2 components:

- Part Payment of Rs. **2,40,000**
- Balance Payment of Rs. **1,67,000**

Program Fee (1st Installment) of Rs. 2,40,000

- On Seat Allotment the candidates are required to pay Rs. 2,40,000 before the last date specified.
- On completion of part payment, the allotted seat is provisionally confirmed

Balance Program Fee (2nd Installment) of Rs. 1,67,000

- Having made the part payment of **Rs. 2,40,000**, the candidate is expected to make the balance fee payment of **Rs. 1,67,000** on or before the timeline mentioned
- If the candidate does NOT complete the part payment process on or before the timeline, the provisionally confirmed seat is forfeited, the candidate will be out of the counseling process.
 - In such a scenario the fee will be deducted as per UGC Refund policy and the rest of the part payment will be refunded back to the candidate.

2.4.2 Pharm D

On seat allotment, first year fees is to be paid within the stipulated timeline. To ease the burden of payment, MAHE Manipal has decided to allow part payment of the fees. The 1st year fee payment of **Rs. 5,90,000** (excluding waitlist deposit of **Rs. 10,000**) is split into 2 components:

- Part Payment of Rs. **2,40,000**
- Balance Payment of Rs. **3,50,000**

Program Fee (1st Installment) of Rs. 2,40,000

- On Seat Allotment the candidates are required to pay Rs. **2,40,000** before the last date specified.
- On completion of part payment, the allotted seat is provisionally confirmed

Balance Program Fee (2nd Installment) of Rs. 3,50,000

- Having made the part payment of Rs. **3,50,000** the candidate is expected to make the balance fee payment of Rs. **3,50,000** on or before the timeline mentioned in Table 1, for that seat allotted
- Failure to make balance fee payment within the timeline provided, will lead to cancellation of allotted seat, candidate will be out of counseling process and paid fee will be refunded as per Refund Rules (Refer Section 6)
 - On cancellation, if the candidate wishes to participate in next round, he / she will have to register afresh by paying the waitlist deposit of Rs. 10,000.

Important Note

- In case of withdrawal (if any) during or after the counseling process, the fee will be deducted as per UGC Refund policy (refer www.manipal.edu/fees)
- Kindly note that this provision (Payment of fee in instalment) is applicable for remitting the First-year fee only for the candidates taking fresh admission in academic year 2026-27.
- From 2nd year onwards, full fee is to be paid at the beginning of every year as per the timeline to be specified by the respective Institute.

2.4.3 Fee Payment Options

Fee payment of 1st & 2nd Installment can be done using 2 methods. Kindly note that transaction charges (if any) **MUST** be borne by the candidate

2.4.3.1 Option 1: Online Payment

- Pay online at <https://apply.manipal.edu>
- The fee receipt acknowledgement will be generated instantly
- You will be able to download the Provisional Admission order instantly, on successful transfer

2.4.3.2 Option 2: NEFT / RTGS Payment

- NEFT / RTGS payment in favor of “Manipal Academy of Higher Education”
 - SB A/c 007201000089, IFSC code ICIC0000072
 - Address: ICICI Bank, Manipal Branch, Kasturba Hospital Complex, Manipal, Karnataka.
 - **No Cash Payments.** Please do not pay the I Instalment Program Fee as cash / cheque directly into the bank account.
- On completion of fee transfer, Login to <https://apply.manipal.edu>, click on “**NEFT payment Details**” to submit the following details

Payment Date, Unique Transaction Reference (UTR) Number, Account Holder’s Name and Amount, Counter slip to be uploaded.

In case of NEFT Payment, if the transaction detail is **NOT** entered by the candidate in candidate portal <https://apply.manipal.edu> as mentioned above within the fee payment deadline, it will be considered that the payment has **NOT** been made, the allotted seat will be cancelled and the candidate will be out-of-the-counseling process and will also **forfeit the waitlist deposit of Rs. 10,000**. Such candidates

will now be considered as Exited Candidates with Forfeiture of Waitlist Deposit

2.5 Provisional Admission Order

Candidate can download the Provisional Admission order from the Counseling portal

- On successful confirmation by the University of fee payment, for freshly allotted candidates
- If / when the seat gets upgraded for provisionally admitted candidates

2.6 Waitlist

The following candidates are eligible for the waitlist

- Registered candidates who have taken a seat in any round and wish to participate in subsequent rounds of counseling (Provisionally Admitted Candidates)
- Registered candidates who have **NOT** been allotted any seat in the previous round. (Waitlisted Candidates)

2.6.1 Waitlist Procedure

The waitlisting process is online at <https://apply.manipal.edu>

- Registered & waitlisted candidates can participate in all rounds of counseling.
 - Registered candidates, who have **NOT** got the seat in the previous round(s), can opt for the waitlist.
 - In case the candidate is **NOT** allotted any seat in any rounds of counseling, the waitlist deposit will be refunded within 1 month of completion of all rounds of Counseling
 - ✓ For this the candidates are required to update the Account details (Name of the account holder, A/c Number, Bank Name, Branch Address and IFSC code) in the Counseling portal. The site is Safe and Secure
- As per Counseling Schedule, Candidates must login to <https://apply.manipal.edu>
 - The candidate can fill in as many choices as possible for waitlisting, from the list as per choices and must click on “**Update Choices**” button.
 - On submission of options by the candidate, it is considered that candidates are very much interested in the options submitted, hence on seat allotment / upgradation, it will be accepted by the candidate. Once allotted, there is no process of reversal. Hence, you may give choices only if you are interested
 - **Candidates are advised to fill in the choices (institutes and Program) of their interest only**
 - After updating, download, save / print a copy of the filled in choices for future reference.
- If the candidate wants to participate in the subsequent round of counseling, he / she can login to the candidate portal <https://apply.manipal.edu> and modify the choices, and click on “Update Choices” button.
 - If a candidate does NOT modify his / her choices at all, then the choices given in the previous round will be considered for the current round, till the final round of BPharm / PharmD Post counseling.
 - If allotment happens, there is no process of reversal. Hence candidates are advised to login, make changes (if necessary) and submit the choices for that round
- If the candidate remains unallotted a seat after the final round of BPharm / PharmD Counseling, the choices provided will become null and void and the waitlist deposit will be refunded.

Important Note

- Seats will be allotted as per MET 2026 rank, availability of vacancy and choices provided.
- All candidates **MUST** login to the portal <https://apply.manipal.edu> to check the Seat Allotment status as per Counseling schedule (Table 1)

- *Non-receipt of SMS / Email confirmation will **NOT** be considered as a reason for non-payment of 1st Instalment fee within the specified deadline.*

On Seat allotment,

- If the **Provisionally admitted candidate** gets upgraded to a new Program in subsequent round(s),
 - The previously allotted Program will be cancelled, and provisional admission order of the previous Program will be null & void
 - The candidate can download the new Provisional Admission order from the Counseling portal.
 - There is **NO** provision to the candidate to revert to the previously allotted Program
 - Balance Course Fee (if any) is to be paid as per the time line provided in Table 2, for the respective round of seat allotted.
 - Failure to make balance fee payment within the timeline provided, will lead to cancellation of allotted seat, candidate will be out of counseling process and paid fee will be refunded as per Refund Rules (Refer Section 6)
 - If the candidate wishes to withdraw, they are required to complete the withdrawal process in the Counseling portal <https://apply.manipal.edu> and the fee paid will be refunded as per UGC Fee refund policy.
 - On withdrawal, the candidates will be out of the Counseling process and will now be considered as the Withdrawn Candidate
- If the **waitlisted candidate** gets a seat allotment for the first time,
 - The candidate has to confirm / accept the seat by paying the first year Program Fee (**1st Installment i.e. Rs. 2,40,000**) for BPharm Course & (**1st Installment i.e. Rs. 2,40,000**) for PharmD. Refer Section 2.4 for Fee Payment.
 - On successful receipt of payment and confirmation by the University, the candidate can download the Provisional Admission order from the Counseling portal. The waitlisted candidate will now be considered as Provisionally Admitted Candidate.
 - On seat allotment, if the first year Course Fee ((**1st Installment i.e. Rs. 2,40,000**) for BPharm Course & (**1st Installment i.e. Rs. 2,40,000**) for PharmD) is **NOT** paid before the deadline specified for that round, candidate is out of the counseling process and will also **forfeit the waitlist deposit of Rs. 10,000**. These candidates will now be considered as Exited Candidates with Forfeiture of Waitlist Deposit
 - Balance Course Fee (**2nd Installment i.e. as per Table 2**) is to be paid as per the time line provided in Table 2, for the respective round of seat allotted. Failure to make balance fee payment within the timeline provided, will lead to cancellation of allotted seat, candidate will be out of counseling process and paid fee will be refunded as per Refund Rules (Refer Section 6)

3. WITHDRAWAL

Withdrawal is an important step for provisionally admitted candidates only

3.1 Before Class commencement (Candidates admitted in Rounds 1 – 4)

All withdrawals before class commencement MUST be made through the candidates portal <https://apply.manipal.edu> only

- The date of submission of the request will be considered as the date of withdrawal.
- The refund will be processed as per the UGC refund policy (Refer section 6).
- Requests for withdrawal via email / telephone / SMS / WhatsApp or any other medium outside of counseling portal will **NOT** be considered.

3.2 After Class commencement

- All withdrawals after class commencement **MUST** be made through the Withdrawal form available at Academic Section of the admitted institute
 - The application form must be submitted along with the No Dues Form at the Academic Section of the admitted institute
 - The date of receipt of the request will be considered as the date of withdrawal.
 - The refund will be processed as per the UGC refund policy (Refer section 8).

Important Note

- *All refunds will be processed based on formally notified last date of admission irrespective of date of admission.*
- *The portal will be blocked during Processing of Seat Allotment dates, hence Withdrawal will not be possible during these dates*

4. FORFEITURE OF WAITLIST DEPOSIT

On seat allotment in any round, if the first year Program Fee (BPharm 1st Installment i.e. Rs. 2,40,000 / PharmD 1st Installment i.e. Rs. 2,40,000) is **NOT** paid before the deadline specified for that round, candidate is out of the counseling process and will also **forfeit the waitlist deposit of Rs. 10,000**. Such candidates will now be considered as Exited Candidates with Forfeiture of Waitlist Deposit

5. WITHDRAWN / EXITED CANDIDATES

On rejection of allotted seat (by Provisionally Admitted / Waitlisted candidates), re-entry is possible only for 2nd, 3rd and 4th round as new registrants by paying waitlist deposit of Rs. 10,000 online.

- The forfeited waitlist deposit of the previous rounds cannot be adjusted with the waitlist deposit fee of the subsequent rounds
- After successful payment of the waitlist deposit, the candidates will be permitted to fill the choices as per section 2.2

6. CANCELLATION OF ADMISSION

- On completion of the admission process, all admitted students **MUST** report to the campus for the Orientation program/ Class Commencement (whichever is earlier) and occupy the allotted hostels.
- Non-reporting to the Campus on the date of Orientation program / Class Commencement (whichever is earlier) will result in automatic Cancellation of Admission.
