  - Click on “**Download Information Brochure**” to download the **MTech/ME Online Counseling Information Brochure**
- Click on “**Pay & Register Now**”
- Read the instructions. Select the check box. Click on “**Pay Now**” button
- Waitlist Deposit (Rs. 10,000) is to be paid online during the Registration process for the Counseling
  - Having made the payment, candidates will be eligible to provide their choices in order to participate in the

Online Counseling process.

- On Seat allotment in any round, 1<sup>st</sup> installment fee has to be paid by the candidate within the timeline specified, to confirm the seat allotment.
  - On fee payment, the waitlist deposit (Rs. 10,000) paid at the time of registration will be converted into Refundable Caution Deposit, which is part of the Course fee.
- Fresh Registration is allowed only at the beginning of 1<sup>st</sup> round.
- Mere registration for the counseling does NOT guarantee the allotment of Seat.
  - Seat allotment depends on the candidates MAHE Merit Rank 2026, the number of candidates registering for the counseling, their choice of course / institution and the number of seats available.

## **2.2 Choice Filling**

**Choice filling is permitted at the beginning of 1<sup>st</sup> round for the registered candidates only**

### **2.2.1 First Time choice Filling**

- To edit the Choices, click on “**Edit Choices**” and after editing click on “**Update Choices**”
- Choice 1 is mandatory
- Choices 2 - 39 are optional.
  - *For Example, if your most preferred Program is M.Tech in Computer Science and Engineering at MIT Manipal, please add it as Choice 1. If your second choice is M.E in Computer Science and Engineering (Cloud Computing) at MSIS Manipal, please add it as Choice 2. If your third choice is M.Tech in Computer Science and Engineering (Data Science) at MIT Bengaluru, please add it as Choice 3 and so on*
- On submission of choices by the candidate, it is considered that candidates are very much interested in the choices submitted, hence on seat allotment / upgradation, it will be accepted by the candidate. Once allotted, there is no process of reversal. Hence, you may give Choices 2 – 39 only if you are interested

- **Candidates are advised to fill in the choices (institutes and Program) of their interest only**
- After saving, download / save / print a copy of the filled choices for future reference.
- Seat will be allotted to the candidates as per MAHE Merit Rank 2026, vacancy and current choice(s) without considering the Program preference number of the previous round(s).

#### **Important Note**

- Request you to fill the choices with the browser zoom option set to 100%
- Candidates are requested to check the correctness of filled choices by clicking "Print" button and save the file for their reference
- The portal will be blocked on Processing of Seat Allotment dates; hence Choice Filling will not be possible during these dates.

### **2.3 Seat Allotment**

The Seat allotment in any round will be as per MAHE Merit Rank 2026, choices provided and availability of the same

- On seat allotment, if the first-year Course Fee (**1<sup>st</sup> Installment i.e. Rs. 1,40,000**) is **NOT** paid before the deadline specified for that round, candidate is out of the counseling process and will also **forfeit the waitlist deposit of Rs. 10,000**. Such candidates will now be considered as Exited Candidates with Forfeiture of Waitlist Deposit
- Balance Course Fee (**2<sup>nd</sup> Installment as mentioned in the below Table 2**) is to be paid as per the time line provided in Table 1, for the respective round of seat allotted.
  - Failure to make balance fee payment within the timeline provided, will lead to cancellation of allotted seat, candidate will be out of counseling process and paid fee will be refunded as per Refund Rules (Refer Section 6)

#### **2.3.1 Program Fee Payment**

On seat allotment, first year fees is to be paid within the stipulated timeline. To ease the burden of payment, MAHE Manipal has decided to allow part payment of the fees. The 1<sup>st</sup> year fee (excluding waitlist deposit of Rs. 10,000) is split into 2 components:

## 2.6 Waitlist

The following candidates are eligible for the waitlist

- Registered candidates who have taken a seat in any round and wish to participate in subsequent rounds of counseling (Provisionally admitted candidates)

### 2.6.1 Waitlist Procedure

### 4. OPT OUT OF COUNSELING

Opt Out is an important step for Provisionally Admitted Candidates and Un-Allotted Candidates

#### 4.1 Provisionally Admitted Candidates

A Provisionally Admitted Candidate is one who has completed the 1<sup>st</sup> Installment Course Fee payment. If the Provisionally admitted candidate is satisfied with the seat allotted in any of the rounds and does not want to participate in the subsequent rounds, he / she can Opt Out of Counseling.

- To opt out, the candidate must login to the candidates' portal <https://apply.manipal.edu> and click on "OPT OUT" button.
  - On "OPT OUT", the allotted seat will be retained and the candidate will NOT be eligible to participate in the subsequent rounds of counseling
- If the candidate does NOT opt out, the choices provided will be considered for subsequent rounds for upgradation as per the vacancy.
  - If the seat is upgraded in the subsequent rounds, candidate has to accept it and he / she has no choice of retaining the previously allotted seat.

*For example, a candidate has been upgraded to M.Tech in Computer Science and Engineering at MIT Manipal from previously provisionally admitted Program of M.Tech in Computer Science and Engineering (Information*

Security) MIT Manipal, then the candidate has to accept the M.Tech in Computer Science and Engineering, MIT Manipal.

- Balance Course Fee (2<sup>nd</sup> Installment as per Table 2) is to be paid as per the time line provided in Table 1, for the respective round of seat allotted.
  - Failure to make balance fee payment within the timeline provided, will lead to cancellation of allotted seat, candidate will be out of counseling process and paid fee will be refunded as per Refund Rules (Refer Section 6)

#### 4.2 Un-Allotted Candidates

An Un-Allotted Candidate is one who has successfully registered to participate in MTech/ME counseling 2026

- If the candidate is NOT allotted any seat in any of the rounds and does **NOT** want to participate in the subsequent rounds, he / she has to Opt Out of Counseling.
  - To opt out, the candidate must login to the candidates' portal <https://apply.manipal.edu> and click on "OPT OUT" button.

### 5. WITHDRAWAL

Withdrawal is an important step for provisionally admitted candidates only

#### 5.1. Before Class commencement (Candidates admitted in Rounds 1 – 3)

- All withdrawals before class commencement must be made through the candidates portal <https://apply.manipal.edu> only
  - The date of submission of the request will be considered as the date of withdrawal.
  - The refund will be processed as per the refund policy (Refer section 8).
  - Requests for withdrawal via email / telephone / SMS / WhatsApp or any other medium outside of counseling portal will NOT be considered.

#### 5.2 After Class commencement

Such candidates will now be considered as Exited Candidates with Forfeiture of Waitlist Deposit

### 6.1 CANCELLATION OF ADMISSION

On completion of the admission process, all admitted students MUST report to the campus for the Orientation program / Class Commencement (whichever is earlier) and occupy the allotted hostels. Non-reporting to the Campus on the date of Orientation program / Class Commencement (whichever is earlier) will result in automatic Cancellation of Admission. On Cancellation of the admission the candidate must proceed with the Withdrawal option. Withdrawal approval and refund process will be initiated only after the receipt of hard copy of the application submitted by the Candidate / Parent / Authorized Representative (in person) at the Admissions Office of the respective Campuses. Fees shall be refunded to an eligible student within Forty-Five days from the date of receipt of hard copy of the application.
